The After School Program provides academic assistance and enriched social activities such as swim instruction, karate, art activities, learning magic, extra computer lab learning, and physical fitness. Children have fun in a safe environment after school.

The program is a New York State licensed program, which is supported by a grant from the New York State Office of Children and Family Services and in collaboration with the East Hampton Union Free School District, the Town of East Hampton, private organizations, and parent tuitions.

Project MOST is based out of the JMMES cafeteria. The cost is \$25 a week, which can be paid yearly, monthly, or weekly. The program runs 3pm-6pm, Monday thru Friday and transportation is NOT provided. Project MOST follows the school calendar. When school is not in session, Project Most is not in session. The group leaders are members from the community, college students, and seniors in high school.

Registration is available at any time. Forms are available in the JMMES Cafeteria each day from 3-6pm. Program staff is available to answer questions. Registration is limited.
